1. How would you describe your career?

NJSP career - I was a member of the NJ state police for 25 years. I have successfully testified in Federal, State, County, and municipal courts.

Private Investigations. I have been a licensed private detective since retiring from the NJSP in February 2011. One of my first cases was a 28-plaintiff sexual harassment and discrimination investigation against a large Atlantic City NJ Casino which was very successful.
